

LOCATION

- Seychelles is an archipelago of over 115 islands in the Indian Ocean, off the east coast of Africa
- Four Seasons is the only resort on Desroches Island – remote and secluded, yet just a 35-minute flight southwest of Mahé, the main island of Seychelles
- A remarkably spacious island, encompassing 402 hectares (933 acres) and edged by 14 kilometres (nine miles) of white sand beaches
