In the Azure waters of the Indian Ocean there is an island like no other. Where nature thrives and man is just a silent observer. Just below the equator and 1000 miles east of Africa, Cousine Island is one of the most untouched granitic islands of the Seychelles archipelago and it is also recognised internationally as one of the most ecologically important private islands on earth.

Health Requirements

No vaccinations are required as the Seychelles is free of tropical diseases such as malaria. A yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travelers who come from or have passed through a partly or wholly infected area within the preceding 6 days.



Climate

- The Seychelles has a warm and tropical climate year round and has temperatures averaging between 25°C and 35°C.
- Sea surface temperatures ranges between 28°C and 31°C
- Rainy season occurs between November and February



Accessibility

- Access to Cousine Island is available via boat or Helicopter transfer from Seychelles International Airport on Mahe Island or from Praslin Island Airport
- The helicopter seats a maximum of 4 guests per transfer and the maximum total weight allowed per transfer combining both passenger and luggage weight is restricted to 325kg (715lb).
- The helicopter seats a maximum of 8 guests per transfer and the maximum total weight allowed per transfer combining both passenger and luggage weight is restricted to 650kg (1430lb).
