Stand Up for Our Seas

In February 2019, four women completed an unprecedented stand up paddle boarding (SUP) expedition in Baa Atoll in the Maldives, raising awareness of the need to protect marine life and the necessary actions to do so. Dr Claire Petros and Dr Cal Major, veterinarians from the UK, and Shaaziya "Saazu" Saeed and Dhafeena "Dhafy" Hassan Ibrahim, Maldivian Ocean Advocates, paddled a gruelling 100km over 8 days. Sponsored by Coco Collection, the expedition began and ended at Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu, the home of the Olive Ridley Project Marine Turtle Rescue Centre; the first and only veterinarian-led turtle rescue centre in the Maldives

Protect Maldives Seagrass Campaign

As part of our dedication to protect and nurture our rich marine life, Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu was delighted to join the nationwide Protect Maldives Seagrass campaign. The Protect Maldives Seagrass campaign, launched on World Seagrass Day on 1st of March 2019, brought together resorts, international advocacy and conservation groups such as Greenpeace and Manta Trust, all advocating for its protection. Lying in the stunning southern waters of Baa Atoll, a designated UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu is proud to pledge to protect the vast seagrass meadow growing within the resort's boundaries.

In-Turtle-Ship of a Lifetime

During the summer of 2019, Coco Collection announced an internship of a lifetime as part of our continuing partnership with the Olive Ridley Project - a charity that works to rescue, rehabilitate, and protect sea turtles in the surrounding Baa Atoll.

The lucky competition winner, veterinary student Jessica Monteiro from Portugal, was flown out to the beautiful Coco Palm Dhuni Kolhu resort in the Maldives for two weeks in August, where she worked at The Marine Turtle Rescue Centre and gained valuable veterinary experience from one of the UK's leading specialist turtle veterinary surgeons, Dr Claire Petros.
